


Proposed Boundary Changes for Hyde-Addison Elementary School 3219 O St. NW

Hyde-Addison Elementary School is the public school of right for all school-age children living within the attendance zone. Families can also apply to charter schools or out of boundary to DCPS schools through a lottery process.

Rationale for Proposed Boundary Changes: Hyde-Addison’s attendance zone expands northwest to relieve pressure at Stoddert and it expands west to relieve pressure at Key. Hyde-Addison is able to expand its boundary since it has few public school students in its current boundary and is scheduled for modernization in 2016-17.

Proposed Geographic Destination Feeder Schools (Feeder Pathway): Anyone living in the proposed new boundary for Hyde-Addison ES is zoned for and has a right to attend Hardy MS and Wilson HS. Any student attending the school out-of-boundary has the right to continue in the feeder pattern to Hardy. Proposed feeder pattern changes were made to better align school building capacity with population and with feeder pattern participation rates and to support racial/ethnic and socio-economic diversity, where possible.

Proposed Programmatic Destination School (Feeder Pathway): No programmatic feeder pattern proposed.
