WINTER SMALL AREA PLAN IMPLEMENTATION UPDATE 2010/2011



Deanwood Strategic Development Plan

Adopted by Council on July 15, 2008 (Resolution Number R17-0704), the <u>Plan</u> is intended to provide an implementation framework for public and private investment in a broad range of areas, leading to neighborhood stabilization and revitalization over a 10-year horizon. This plan provides a clear and concise outline for how development can and should happen in the Deanwood neighborhood.

IMPLEMENTATION PROGRESS

In Fiscal Year 2010, there has been a lot progress made Deanwood such as renovations at the Marvin Gaye Park and the construction of a state of the art Deanwood Recreation facility. Importantly, the Deanwood Taskforce was established in February. The Taskforce is a specific recommendation in the Plan that organizes community leaders and stakeholders to assist and lead certain implementation activities that require little to no funding. Initiated by the Office of Planning the Taskforce concept is the first of its kind

to be used for implementation purposes. One of its first activities will be the Deanwood Housing Workshop on 9/18/2010, organized to inform neighborhood homeowners and seniors about District resources available for the renovation of their homes and tax relief programs for residents.

Great Streets improvements have begun on Nannie Helen Burroughs Avenue (NHB). The upgrades will improve the pedestrian experience with improved sidewalks and streetlights. Storefront and interior improvements for specific businesses, organized through the Deanwood Heights Main Streets and funded through DLSBD, will also revitalize the corridor
