


During discussion of the application at the February 26th, 2021 meeting, the Commemorative Works Committee identified additional information needed for consideration as part of its review:

- Lighting of the statue;
- Finish of the bronze;
- Information on the commemorative work through an interpretive panel or digital media; and,
- Renderings showing the proposed statue together with its surrounding architectural features (stairs, building entrance/door, etc.).

Exterior Lighting PlanLocation of Light Fixtures






DDOT does not support non-standard lights in public space and noted a streetlight less than 20' from the proposed location is part of approved streetscape plans. The lighting specialist for the project also determined additional lighting is not needed.

Finish of the Bronze

The material and finish of the sculpture at the African American Civil War Memorial and proposed statue of Lincoln are identical. There may be a slight difference initially because of the weathering of the existing sculpture.

Interpretive Panel or Digital Media

- The sponsor will provide a mobile application to inform the public about the Lincoln statue, African American Civil War Memorial Plaza, and the African American Civil War Memorial Museum.
- The mobile application will use GPS (Global Positioning System) to identify other locations of interest, exhibits, Wall of Honor and Lincoln Statue to visitors.
- All mobile application information will be available directly to user through cell phone display.
