
## What is Zoning?



## **Zoning in DC:**


- ☐ Must be "not inconsistent" with the Comprehensive Plan
- Establishes "Zones" or "Zone Districts" for different parts of the District
- Defines what can be built and what kinds of uses are permitted
- In each zone, certain development is allowed by-right

## DC's zoning laws tell people:

- □ How a property may be used, either "by-right" or with BZA or ZC approval
- Building setback siting on a property
- How much can be built on a property how tall, how big, how many stories, how much land can be covered
- ☐ The process for relief from the regulations

## How cities use zoning:

- ☐ Guide future development of communities in accordance with the Comprehensive Plan and Small Area Plans
- ☐ An important way to implement Land Use Policy
- ☐ Foster retention of, or changes to, the look and feel of an area
- ☐ Promote or restrict certain uses in defined areas District of Columbia
- ☐ Encourage adequate light and air around property
