

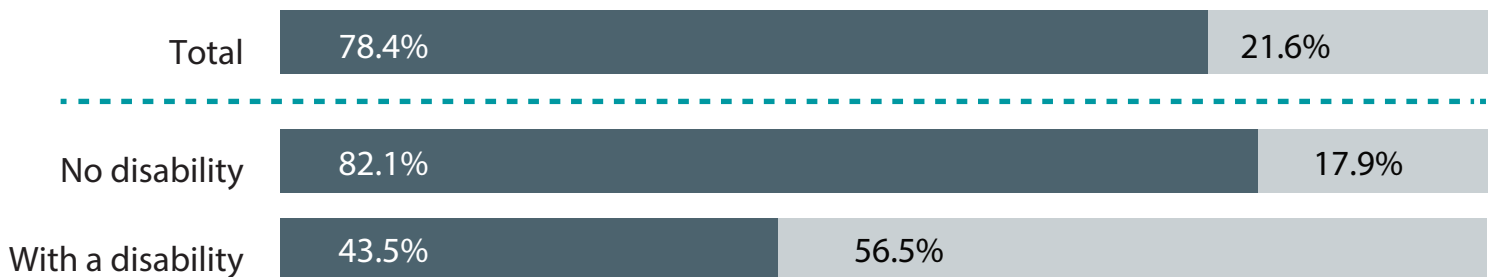

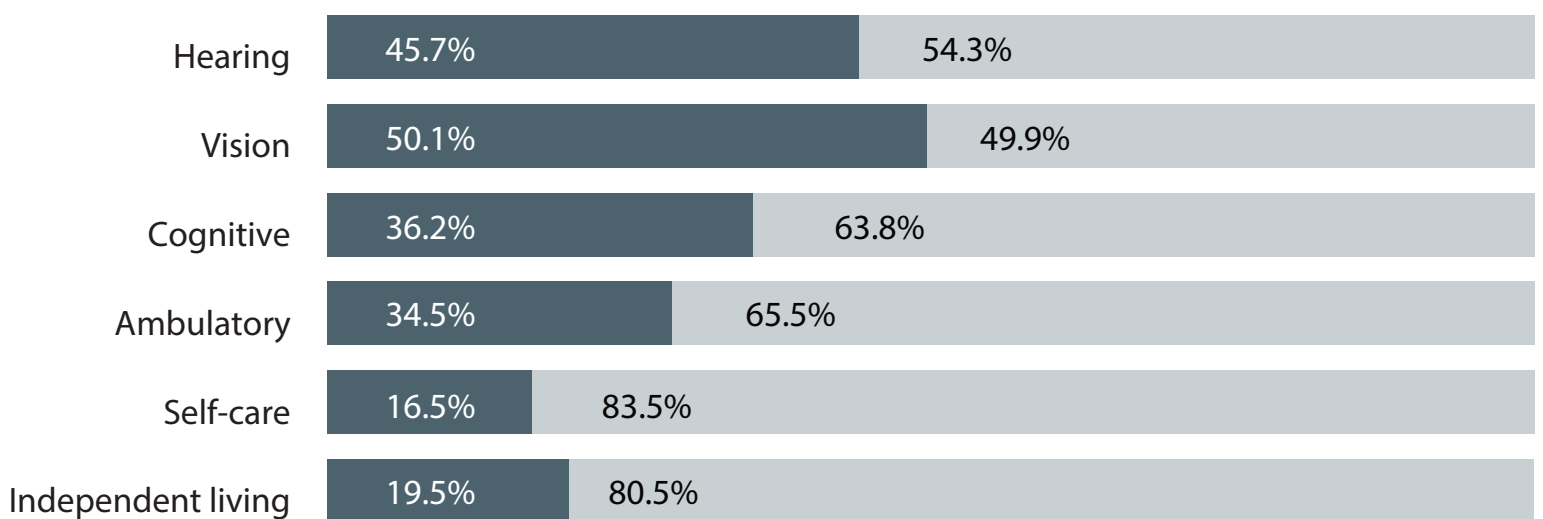
People With Disabilities About Half as Likely to Participate in the Labor Force
