Applicant Aaron Meyers, with plans by architect Michael Fowler, seeks concept review for a two-story rear addition at a property located in the Capitol Hill Historic District.

# **Property Description**

1236 Walter Street SE was built in 1912 by Harry Kite based on a design by A. E. Landvoigt as one in a row of eight. The brick porch-front two-story rowhome has a garage at the alley, a fenced yard, and a second-story deck at the rear of the property.

## **Proposal**

The existing rear ell (dogleg) would be demolished and replaced with a full-width addition extending back twenty feet. The new rear elevation would be clad in fiber cement siding boards. The first story would have two windows ganged together with a door, on the second story there would be three windows ganged together. The side elevations would also be clad in fiber cement siding.

### **Evaluation**

This property has a rear ell but is not part of a row with rear ells, and there are not intact rear ells for the block frontage. The project is compatible with the building and historic district.

#### Recommendation

The HPO recommends the Board find the project compatible with the Capitol Hill historic district, and delegate authority to HPO Staff.
