Overmyer Architects, representing the owners, seeks conceptual design review for construction of a two-story rear addition on a frame house in the Cleveland Park Historic District. As the property is located on a corner, the addition would abut and be seen from Porter Street. The house was built in 1913 and designed by Gregg & Leisenring architects.

## Proposal

The project calls for removing a small one-story addition and constructing a two-story frame addition with a one-story enclosed breakfast room projecting off of that. The two-story addition would be clad in clapboard and have six-over-one windows to match those on the house; the one-story addition would be detailed as an enclosed porch with ganged six-over-one windows.

## Evaluation

The massing of the addition is subordinate to the house, and its design is contextual and compatible in its fenestration, materials, detailing and roofline.

## Recommendation

The HPO recommends that the Review Board find the proposal compatible with the character of the historic district and delegate final approval to staff.
