Thomas P. Brown Management LLC, with plans prepared by Bonstra Haresign Architects, seeks conceptual design review for new construction in the 14<sup>th</sup> Street Historic District.

## **Property Description**

1319 R Street is currently occupied by a flat-front, three-story apartment building constructed in 1952 that is not contributing as it falls outside the district's period of significance (1855-1940). The building is flanked by three-story, bay-fronted brick rowhouses in a variety of forms and architectural styles from the late-19<sup>th</sup> century.

### Proposal

The project calls for replacing the existing structure with a three-story, bay-fronted, multi-unit building above a raised basement. The building would be brick with a metal bay with single light casement windows topped with transoms. Multi-hued brickwork, belt courses and metal profiles would provide detailing and patterning.

### Evaluation

The design is compatible in its height, mass, façade composition, materials, and pattern of fenestration with the street and historic district.

#### Recommendation

The HPO recommends that the Review Board approve the concept and delegate final approval to staff.
