

POSTING REQUIREMENTS FOR GEORGETOWN PROJECTS REFERRED TO THE U.S. COMMISSION OF FINE ARTS

The preservation law requires that applicants for project review by the Old Georgetown Board of the Commission of Fine Arts give public notice of the case by posting placard(s) at the property, and that direct notice be given to immediate neighbors and the affected Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC). This notice is required by law (D.C Official Code § 6-1108.03).

When filing a project for HPRB review by the Old Georgetown Board, the Historic Preservation Office (HPO) staff fills out the placard(s) for the applicant and makes copies of the completed placard for distribution to abutting and confronting properties, and to the affected ANC. The applicant is responsible for posting the placard(s) on the property and providing an electronic version of the plans, which HPO can distribute to the ANC and any interested party upon request. HPO mails the direct notice to the immediate neighbors and the ANC on the applicant's behalf.

		Post the placard(s) at each street frontage on the property involved, in a conspicuous place in plain view where they can be seen and read by the public.
		If there are multiple buildings subject to the review, post additional placard(s) on the front of each building subject to the review.
		Post the placard(s) no later than five (5) days after filing the application. Placards must be posted in time to give the public a minimum of 21 days' notice before the Commission of Fine Arts meeting.
		Maintain the placard(s) in place until the date of the Commission of Fine Arts hearing.

		Email or deliver an electronic copy of plans to HPO by the day after submission of the application.
